Training programmes for women honchos by ISB

New Delhi, Nov. 11: The Indian School of Business (ISB) on Thursday said it will be conducting a series of training programmes for women entrepreneurs across the country, starting next month.

The initiative, fully-funded by the Goldman Sachs Foundation, would provide business and management education to underserved women entrepreneurs. The Foundation is the philanthropic arm of US banking major Goldman Sachs.

Hyderabad-based ISB said the programme would benefit women entrepreneurs running small and medium-sized businesses.

The 16-week programme would have three weeks of

The programme would begin in New Delhi on December 18 and women entrepreneurs from Delhi,

NCR, Punjab, Haryana, UP would be eligible to apply, ISB said in a statement.

To create awareness about the programme, ISB will organise an information session at India International Centre here on Friday.

Later, the programme would also be conducted in three other cities — Bengaluru, Pune and Hyderabad.

The criteria for participants include their business venture having annual revenues between ₹ 5 lakh to 50 lakh.

More than 200 women entrepreneurs have benefited from the initiative, which was launched in 2008, ISB added. — PTI
